**Program Overview:**

This program will provide a comprehensive update on significant legal and regulatory changes, including the following:

On May 3, 2019, CMS published draft guidance regarding space sharing between co-located hospitals and hospitals co-located with other healthcare entities. This new guidance answers a number of longstanding provider questions regarding co-location and co-mingling of services between co-located providers. At the same time, this new guidance leaves open a number of ongoing issues for hospital provider-based facilities, building construction, rural facility compliance, and other operational hurdles.

Join us for this discussion of CMS’ new guidance and interpretation of space-sharing restrictions, operational hurdles for provider operations, and opportunities for ongoing provider input as CMS policy develops.
