

“EPA Subpart P- What You Need to Know Webinar”

Program Overview:

The Environmental Protection Agency’s (EPA) new Subpart P regulations drastically change how pharmaceutical waste is managed in a healthcare setting. This webinar will discuss how healthcare facilities will be impacted and strategies to ensure compliance.
