3. Healthcare partner identifies jobs that fit your career goals.



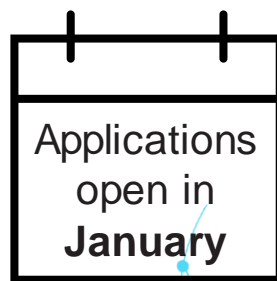
4. Apply for a job and accept offer if one is made!
